TREES

ASH, 'Rosehill':

A vigorous *White Ash* with an upright, oval growth habit. Glossy, dark green foliage turns bronze-red to purple in fall. Tolerates wet, heavy clay soils well. Rapid growth in moist soil. AMH 40' AMS 30'

ASH, 'Urbanite':

An upright, pyramidal *Green Ash* with thick, leathery dark green foliage. Thick bark resists sunscald and borer damage. Fall color ranges from bronze-purple to yellow tones. Very heat and drought tolerant once established.

AMH 45' AMS 35'

BALD CYPRESS:

The majestic "Swamp Cypress" of the Southern states. Soft fine needles make it resemble an evergreen. Distinct pyramidal growth. Fall color is russet-red, with leaves retained into the winter. Very hardy, fast growing and grows well in "those wet problem areas". AMH 50' AMS 25'

BIRCH, RIVER 'Dura-Heat' Clump:

An excellent choice for any Kansas landscape. This selection of birch has heat resistant, glossy deep green foliage with a dense branching habit. Attractive cream-tan colored bark peels year round. Fast growing. Yellow fall color in late October thru early November. AMH 40' AMS 30'

BIRCH, RIVER 'HERITAGE':

An excellent choice for any landscape. We recommend this birch over the White Birch as it is much better adapted to the Kansas climate. Withstands heat and wind when provided adequate moisture during drought periods. Tolerant of poor soils and exposed sites. Beautiful peeling bark reveals mottled areas of cream, orange and pinkish colors with growth. A fast growing, graceful tree with large dark green foliage in summer, turning golden yellow in fall.

BLACK GUM:

Slow to moderate growing tree. Does well in wet locations. A picturesque tree with spectacular fall color, ranging from hues of brilliant red to red-orange. Requires moist, slightly acidic soil and protection from hot south wind. AMH 30' AMS 20'

CHINESE PISTACHE:

Medium to fast growth rate. Upright branching with round crown. Dark green summer foliage becomes yellow, orange and red in fall. Resistant to disease and insects. Tolerates heat and drought well. Must have good drainage to grow well.

COTTONWOOD, Cottonless 'Noreaster':

The state tree of Kansas. Very fast growing with rounded, spreading form. Shimmering, glossy green leaves with golden yellow fall color. Allow adequate space.

AMH 60-80' AMS 40'

COTTONWOOD, Cottonless 'Mighty Moe':

Large, spreading tree. A very fast growing shade tree with glossy green leaves, turning bright yellow in fall.

AMH 60' AMS 40'

CRAB, 'Adams':

A dense, rounded crabapple having deep pink flowers and carmine-red fruit which persists through the winter. The new foliage has a red tint, becoming green in summer, with beautiful orange-red fall color. Highly disease resistant.

AMH 20' AMS 20'

CRAB, 'David':

A compact, medium size tree with upright, rounded shape. Has excellent green foliage, that is disease resistant. Pink buds open into large white flowers. The small, bright red fruit persists into winter.

AMH 12' AMS 12'

CRAB, 'Donald Wyman':

A highly rated disease resistant crabapple with an upright shape in youth becoming rounded at maturity. The pink buds open to become white flowers in spring. Glossy green summer foliage and bright red fruit in fall which persists through the winter. An excellent tree for all seasons.

AMH 20' AMS 20'

CRAB, 'Golden Raindrops':

An upright, vase shaped tree with unusual fine textured foliage. Glossy green deeply cut leaves turn orange-yellow in fall. White flowers are followed by tiny golden yellow fruit in fall. Excellent disease resistance. AMH 18' AMS 15'

CRAB, 'Louisa':

A pink flowering weeping crabapple with excellent form and dark green glossy foliage. Excellent disease resistance. True pink flowers followed by small yellow fruit. AMH 10' AMS 12'

CRAB, 'Pink Princess':

A naturally dwarf tree with a low, spreading form. Covered in rose-pink flowers each spring, bronze-purple summer foliage, and deep red fruit in fall. An excellent small ornamental tree for limited spaces! AMH 6-8' AMS 6-8'

CRAB, 'Prairifire':

Rosy red flowers followed by cone shaped maroon fruit, which persists into winter. Reddish maroon foliage maturing to dark green during the summer. Upright growth habit. Disease resistant. AMH 18' AMS 15'

CRAB, 'Purple Prince':

An outstanding crabapple with purple-bronze foliage, rosy-red flowers, small maroon fruit and red-purple bark. Excellent disease resistance. Vigorous, upright, rounded growth habit. AMH 20' AMS 20'

CRAB, 'Red Barron':

An upright, columnar variety having red flowers and bright, cherry-red fruit. Useful in restricted areas or where a columnar form is desired. Beautiful orange-red fall color. AMH 18' AMS 6'

CRAB, 'Red Jade':

An outstanding flowering crabapple with white flowers in spring and abundant cherry red fruits in autumn which persist into winter. The tree is weeping with vivid green summer foliage. AMH 10' AMS 15'

CRAB, 'Royal Raindrops':

An excellent new crabapple having deep purple-red cutleaf foliage. Bright pinkish red flowers in spring, with small red persistent fruit in fall. Upright, spreading form with excellent disease resistance. AMH 18' AMS 15'

CRAB, SARGENT 'Candymint':

A dwarf crabapple with purplish-bronze foliage and pink flowers. Wavy growth habit of branches adds interest to the low horizontal shape. An excellent choice where space is limited! AMH 6-8' AMS 6-8'

CRAB, SARGENT 'Tina':

A natural dwarf crabapple with low, spreading horizontal branches. Profuse single white fragrant flowers are followed by small bright red fruit. Excellent tree; disease resistant. AMH 6' AMS 6'

CRAB, 'Snowdrift':

An outstanding white-flowering crabapple. Each spring, pink buds are followed by masses of white flowers. Very small green fruit, changes to glossy orange-red and is relished by birds. Tree forms a sturdy straight trunk with broad oval head. AMH 18' AMS 15'

CRAB, 'Spring Snow':

Fruitless. Masses of pure white flowers cover the tree in spring. Dark green foliage all summer. Upright, oval shape. AMH 18' AMS 15'

CRAB, 'Zumi':

An excellent, gracefully spreading tree with pink buds, white flowers and persistent bright red fruit. One of the most fruitful crabapples, relished by birds. Highly recommended for flowering & abundant fruit. Disease resistant foliage turning yellow-orange in fall. AMH 15' AMS 12'

DOGWOOD, Chinese 'Milky Way':

A selection of *Chinese Dogwood* with superior, long lasting white flower display in late spring. Abundant bright orange-red fruit and excellent red fall foliage color. Prefers afternoon shade with moist, well-drained acidic soil. Mulch recommended. AMH 12' AMS 12'

DOGWOOD, Pink Flowering 'Prairie Pink':

A superior selection from the KSU John C. Pair Horticultural Research Center. This pink flowering dogwood exhibits better heat and drought tolerance than other types. Excellent winter bud hardiness has also shown reliable spring blooming. Although a tougher tree for a dogwood, we still recommend planting in a protected area for best performance. AMH 12' AMS 12'

DOGWOOD, White Flowering 'Cloud 9':

A selection of *White Flowering Dogwood* which produces large white flowers each spring. Rounded flower bracts with overlapping petals. Red fall foliage. Plant in well-drained soil with afternoon shade. Mulch also recommended. AMH 12' AMS 12'

ELM, AMERICAN 'Valley Forge':

A broad vase-shaped tree with arching limbs. A fast growing tree with deep green foliage, yellow fall color. AMH 50' AMS 40'

ELM, 'Patriot':

A new hybrid selection of elm, which is very disease resistant. Very fast growth with an upright vase shape. AMH 40' AMS 30'

ELM, LACEBARK (Chinese):

This is an excellent medium size, round headed shade tree. Graceful, broadly arching branches are covered with deep green finely toothed small leaves. Outer bark flakes to reveal beautiful orange-brown inner bark. Very hardy, no disease or insect problems and a much stronger tree than the common Siberian Elm. Rapid growth. Tolerates poor soil. AMH 40' AMS 35'

ELM, LACEBARK 'Allee':

Another excellent cultivar. Upright, vase shaped tree with rich green leaves. Fall color ranges yellow to red. Beautiful bark coloring. Disease and insect resistant. Rapid growing. Tolerates poor soil. AMH 40' AMS 30'

ELM, LACEBARK 'Bosque':

A new cultivar of *Lacebark Elm* with excellent upright oval shape. Rapid growth rate. AMH 40' AMS 30'

ELM, LACEBARK 'Dynasty':

A fast growing tree with a fine textured foliage. Broadly rounded, spreading shape. Performs well in any soil type. Yellowish-orange fall color. AMH 40' AMS 40'

ELM, LACEBARK 'Frontier':

An excellent, rapid growing tree with an upright, oval shape. Glossy green leaves turn beautiful reddish-purple to burgundy in October. Disease and insect resistant. Also grows well in poor soil. AMH 40' AMS 30'

EUONYMUS, WINTERBERRY

'Pink Lady':

A beautiful small multi-stem tree for any landscape. Excellent dark green fine textured summer foliage turns brilliant red in fall. Brilliant large pink fruit capsules open to expose orange seeds in October, which are persistent into early winter. Performs best in moist soils. AMH 18' AMS 12'

GINKGO, 'Autumn Gold':

Very hardy, slow growing tree with unique fan-shaped leaves. Foliage turns a brilliant gold in fall. Performs best in moist soils. AMH 30' AMS 20'

GOLDENRAIN TREE:

Round-headed tree that is covered with yellow flowers in summer. Attractive, lantern-like seed pods hang on into late fall. AMH 30' AMS 25'

HACKBERRY, 'Chinese':

Rapid growing, with glossy green leaves. Very smooth, attractive bark. Drought tolerant. AMH 30' AMS 25'

HACKBERRY, 'Prairie Pride':

A medium to fast growing, extremely hardy tree for Kansas. Will tolerate drought, wind and poor soils. This selection has an upright growth habit and good foliage quality. Deep green leaves turning yellow in fall. AMH 40-60' AMS 40-60'

HAWTHORN, 'Thornless Cockspur':

Round-headed with horizontal, dense branching habit. Lustrous dark green foliage turns orange to scarlet in fall. White flowers in spring, followed by bright red fruit. AMH 20' AMS 15'

HAWTHORN, 'Washington':

Bright, shiny green leaves turn brilliant orange-red in fall. White flowers in spring turn into clusters of orange-red berries in the fall. The persistent fruit is relished by birds. Extremely hardy, beautiful tree for any landscape. AMH 20' AMS 18'

HORSECHESTNUT, 'AUTUMN SPLENDOR':

An excellent ornamental tree for protected sites. Dark green, shiny leaves that turn vivid maroon-red in fall. Yellow-red flower spikes at the ends of the branches in late spring. Prefers moist soil and must be protected from wind and afternoon sun. AMH 25' AMS 25'

HORSECHESTNUT, 'BAUMANII'

Double Horsechestnut. Double white flowers with pink flecks. Fruitless. Nine inch panicles bloom later than other varieties. Best grown in a protected area. AMH 25' AMS 25'

LILAC, CHINESE TREE:

A beautiful small tree with fine textured foliage and small white flowers in early summer. Attractive bark patterns and brown seed pods add winter interest.

Requires well-drained soil. AMH 20' AMS 12'

LILAC, JAPANESE TREE:

A very handsome, small tree. Large green leaves on upright branches. Large loose bunches of white flowers in June, followed by brown seedpods in fall. Attractive bark. Requires well-drained soil. AMH 30' AMS 15'

LINDEN, LITTLELEAF 'Greenspire':

An excellent selection of *Littleleaf Linden*. Maintains a strong central leader, with very uniform branching for a symmetrical, pyramidal form. Dark green heart-shaped foliage, yellow fall color. Best in moist, but well-drained soil.

AMH 30' AMS 20'

LOCUST, 'Skyline':

Stately and unusual variety with pyramidal form. Branches are uniformly spaced and diverge from trunk at wide angle. The small, dark green leathery leaves provide filtered shade, turn bright yellow in fall and disappear into the grass, creating no litter problem. An excellent patio or street tree. Medium to fast growing. Drought tolerant, seedless, thornless, tough. Does well in clay soil.

AMH 40' AMS 30'

LOCUST, 'Sunburst':

An irregular, spreading tree with unique, picturesque form. The new growth is always bright yellow, contrasting with the bright green of the balance of the tree. Heat and drought tolerant. Medium to fast growing. Seedless and thornless. Does well in clay soil. AMH 35' AMS 35'

LONDON PLANE TREE, 'Bloodgood':

Similar to *American Sycamore*, but more refined with smaller leaves. Disease resistant, with attractive mottled bark. Fast growing, does very well under adverse city conditions. AMH 50' AMS 40'

MAGNOLIA, 'Betty', 'Jane' or 'Susan':

These are multi-stem trees which are intermediate in size between *Star* and *Saucer Magnolia*. Flower buds are long and purple, open to deep purple-red blooms, which are lighter pinkish inside. The deep green foliage turns golden yellow in fall. Upright, spreading form, with dense branching. AMH 12' AMS 6-8'

MAGNOLIA, 'Black Tulip':

Showy brilliant ruby-red 10-12" flowers are spectacular in spring. When young, this tree is upright, becoming more rounded with age. Best growth with moist acid soil conditions. Full Sun. AMH 20' AMS 15'

MAGNOLIA, 'Royal Star':

A multiple stem large shrub or small tree with fragrant white flowers in early spring. Dark green summer foliage turning bronze yellow in fall. Performs best with moist soil. AMH 8' AMS 6'

MAGNOLIA, SAUCER 'Alexandrina':

A small tree valued for its beautiful pink and white fragrant flowers which appear in early spring. Large, bright green leaves cover the wide spreading branches during summer. Performs best in acidic, moist soil, with protection from south wind. AMH 20' AMS 15'

MAGNOLIA, SOUTHERN 'Bracken's Brown Beauty':

A superior selection which is very cold tolerant. Glossy, dark green leaves are accented with rusty brown undersides. Large, fragrant white flowers in summer. Upright, dense, pyramidal growth habit. Best growth in moist, acidic, well-drained soil. AMH 25' AMS 15'

MAGNOLIA, SOUTHERN 'Edith Bogue':

A selection of *Southern Magnolia* with increased cold tolerance. Upright, pyramidal shape with large white flowers in summer. The evergreen leaves withstand snow and ice well. Does well in limited space. AMH 25' AMS 12-15'

MAGNOLIA, SOUTHERN 'Little Gem':

A compact, upright magnolia with shiny evergreen leaves. Smaller foliage than other selections. Fragrant white flowers throughout the late spring and summer. Slow growth rate. AMH 15' AMS 8-10'

MAGNOLIA, SOUTHERN 'Teddy Bear':

A very compact *Southern Magnolia* with an upright branching habit. The small glossy, dark green leaves have a reddish-brown, heavily felted back. White, fragrant flowers are 6-8" wide, blooms in early-midsummer. AMH 15' AMS 8-10'

NOTE: Japanese Maples - Best in acidic soil MUST be planted where protected from south & west wind in July & August. Prefers moist soil and afternoon shade.

JAPANESE MAPLES

MAPLE, JAP.GREEN 'Fernleaf FullMoon':

A small maple grown for its beautiful foliage. The soft green leaves have very deeply cut lobes, with margins sharply toothed. The foliage turns brilliant shades of pink, orange and red in fall. Attractive branching habit that becomes rounded with age. AMH 15' AMS 10'

MAPLE, JAP.RED 'Bloodgood':

A small, slow growing tree with beautiful fine-textured red foliage throughout the growing season and purple-red stems during winter. AMH 15' AMS 10'

MAPLE, JAP.RED 'Emperor 1':

An upright *Japanese Maple* with excellent deep red foliage throughout the growing season. Interesting blackish-red bark. Brilliant scarlet fall color. AMH 15' AMS 10'

MAPLE, JAP.RED 'Inaba Shidare':

A vigorous growing lace-leaf *Japanese Maple* with rich, purple-red foliage through the summer, becoming bright red in the fall. Growth habit is a dense graceful cascading shape, very distinctive even in winter! AMH 6-8' AMS 6-8'

MAPLE, JAP.RED 'Red Dragon':

Lace-leaf with cascading branches. Bright red foliage that turns darker red in summer. AMH 6-8' AMS 6-8'

MAPLE, JAP.RED 'Tamukeyama':

An old variety which has consistently been highly rated for its dark purple-red leaf color and vigorous growth habit. The foliage resists heat-scorch better than many other lace-leaf types. Bold, coarsely dissected foliage for a laceleaf variety. AMH 6-8' AMS 6-8'

MAPLES

MAPLE, AMUR:

A small ornamental maple often grown in clump form, but may also be grown as a single stem tree. Dark green, deeply cut foliage turns brilliant red in fall. While very hardy and adaptable to poor soils, does best with adequate moisture. Very effective as large hedge or screen. AMH 15' AMS 15'

MAPLE, AMUR 'Bailey Compact':

A more compact form of *Amur Maple* with very dense branching and fine-textured foliage. The glossy green summer foliage turns beautiful shades of orange-red to scarlet in fall. A great specimen, screen or accent plant. AMH 6-8' AMS 6'

MAPLE, 'Autumn Blaze':

A hybrid between *Red and Silver Maple* having the better qualities of both trees. Combines the drought tolerance of Silver Maple with the better branching habit of Red Maple. Fast growing with long lasting, brilliant red fall color. AMH 50' AMS 40'

MAPLE, NORWAY 'Crimson King':

Large glossy, dark red leaves throughout the growing season distinguish this tree from all others. A slow growing tree which must be planted where protected from hot south winds, with moist soil conditions. AMH 30' AMS 25'

MAPLE, 'Paperbark':

A rare, slow growing *Asiatic Maple* with beautiful orangish-brown exfoliating bark. Small, dark green lobed leaves turning deep red in fall. Upright, rounded shape with age. Best planted in a protected area with afternoon shade, moist, well-drained soil. AMH 15' AMS 8-10'

MAPLE, 'Queen Elizabeth':

A small to medium size tree with corky bark and attractive foliage. Glossy dark green in summer, with yellow fall color. Very dense upright rounded branching habit. A very heat and drought tolerant tree, but must have good drainage to grow well. Group them together for an excellent screen or hedge. AMH 20' AMS 15'

MAPLE, RED 'Brandywine':

A vigorous growing tree with a broadly oval to rounded branching pattern. Lustrous green foliage in summer, turning brilliant red in fall. Colors one to two weeks earlier than October Glory. Heat and drought tolerant once established. Best growth in moist soil. AMH 30' AMS 30'

MAPLE, RED 'Burgundy Belle':

An excellent cultivar of *Red Maple* discovered in Northeast Kansas. This selection withstands heat and drought well once established. Bright glossy-green leaves turn brilliant maroon-red in late October. Rounded, spreading shape with age. Best growth in moist soil. AMH 35' AMS 30'

MAPLE, RED 'October Glory':

A dense, rounded tree with glossy, green foliage. Beautiful, brilliant-red fall color in late October. Holds leaves late for extended color. Heat and drought tolerant once established. Faster growth in moist soil. AMH 30' AMS 30'

MAPLE, RED 'Sun Valley':

Oval, symmetrical tree with dense branches, small leaves. Bright red fall color. AMH 30' AMS 25'

MAPLE, SHANTUNG:

A small maple with potential for street or residential areas. Small round-headed tree of neat outline with a regular branching pattern. Reddish purple leaves when emerging; yellow-orange-red fall color. AMH 20-25' AMS 20'

MAPLE, 'Silver Queen':

Seedless. A good tough native tree for large sites. Fast growing, leaves deeply cut, green above, silver underneath. Bark light gray. Golden yellow fall color. AMH 60' AMS 50'

MAPLE, SUGAR CADDO 'Autumn Splendor':

A K-State selection of *Sugar Maple* with thick, tough leaves that resist leaf scorch. This tree has performed well in our area. The glossy dark green leaves hold up well throughout the summer, turning red-orange in fall. Slow to moderate growth rate, with upright, spreading habit. Will perform best in moist but well-drained fertile soil. AMH 40' AMS 30'

MAPLE, SUGAR CADDO 'John Pair':

A K-State selection of *Sugar Maple* somewhat like Autumn Splendor, but slower growing with denser, rounder habit. AMH 35' AMS 30'

MAPLE, SUGAR CADDO (Seedling):

A selection of *Sugar Maple* with thicker, glossy, dark green leaves which resist heat stress. Beautiful yellow-orange-red fall color. Best growth in well drained soils. AMH 40' AMS 30'

MAPLE, 'Trident':

A rare, medium sized *Asiatic Maple* with rounded form. Small, dark green leaves throughout summer, changing to beautiful shades of yellow-orange to red in fall. AMH 30' AMS 20'

MIMOSA, 'Rosea':

An improved selection of mimosa. Very fast growing, spreading tree with fine, fern-like foliage. Large rosy-pink flowers cover the tree in June. AMH 30' AMS 30'

MULBERRY, 'Chaparral' Weeping:

Cascading, slender branches create attractive appearance. Bright green leaves, fast growing and fruitless. Useful as accent or specimen plant. Outstanding in winter. AMH 10' AMS 6'

OAK, BUR:

A large, broadly oval native tree, with a thick trunk and stout branches. Large green leaves turn yellow in fall. Does well in alkaline soils. Very drought tolerant. AMH 50' AMS 40'

OAK, CHINKAPIN:

A very durable tree with nice glossy, dark green foliage. Native to the eastern part of Kansas. Tolerates poor soil and drought. Yellowish fall color. AMH 40' AMS 40'

OAK, ENGLISH:

Broad spreading rounded form. Dark green summer foliage becomes yellowish-brown in fall and holds on the tree through winter. Moderate to fast growth rate, and tolerant of heavy clay soils. Performs best with adequate moisture. AMH 50' AMS 40'

OAK, PYRAMIDAL ENGLISH 'Crimson Spire':
An *English Oak* with columnar growth habit. The glossy bluish-green leaves turn rusty maroon-red in fall. Excellent choice for limited spaces and screening.
AMH 40' AMS 15'

OAK, PYRAMIDAL ENGLISH 'Regal Prince':
An excellent columnar oak with glossy, green foliage. Great for screening or in tight spaces where upright effect is desired. AMH 40' AMS 15'

OAK, PYRAMIDAL ENGLISH 'Skyrocket':
A narrow upright form of *English Oak*. Dark green leaves turn yellow-brown in fall, retained into winter. Excellent where space is limited. AMS 40' AMS 15'

OAK, NUTTALL:
An upright, pyramidal tree when young, becoming broad spreading with age. Dark green, deeply lobed leaves, similar to Shumard or Pin Oak. Tolerates heat and drought once established. Also tolerates wet soil much better than Shumard or Red Oak. Fast growth rate, excellent maroon-red fall color.
AMH 40' AMS 30'

OAK, PIN:
An excellent shade tree with very distinct growth habit. Very symmetrical, pyramidal form with dense horizontal branching habit. Moderate to fast growth rate. Dark green foliage turning rusty orange to scarlet-maroon in fall. AMH 50' AMS 30'

OAK, RED:
One of our FINEST trees. Forms a large upright rounded tree. Dark green foliage turning a bright red in the fall. Moderate growth rate. Must have well-drained soil.
AMS 50' AMS 40'

OAK, SAWTOOTH:
Moderate to rapid growing shade tree. Adapts to wide range of growing conditions. Dense, upright, rounded growth habit with sawtooth edged leaves. Golden yellow fall color. AMH 40' AMS 40'

OAK, SHINGLE:
Medium growth rate. Pyramidal to upright oval form. Dark green summer foliage changing to russet-red in fall, then brown leaves remain on tree into winter. Excellent for shade and street planting. Best growth in well-drained soil.
AMH 50' AMS 35'

OAK, SHUMARD:
A very desirable shade tree with an upright, spreading growth habit. Foliage is glossy green turning bright red-maroon in fall. Moderate to fast growth rate. Tolerates poor, alkaline soils and less subject to iron chlorosis than Pin Oak. Best growth in well-drained soil.
AMH 50' AMS 35'

OAK, SWAMP WHITE:
A moderate to fast growing oak having dark green leaves with wavy margins that are white underneath and retained during winter. Rounded open form with ornamental, roughly fissured bark. Tolerates wet, poorly drained soils and has yellow to reddish brown fall color. AMH 45' AMS 40'

OAK, WATER:
A moderate to fast growing oak with small dark green foliage. Upright when small becomes large spreading tree. Tolerates wet soil better than most other oaks. Reddish fall color. AMH 40' AMS 35'

OAK, WILLOW:

OSAGE ORANGE, 'Whiteshield':

A slow growing, flat-topped spruce with silver-blue needles. Forms a compact globe which has greater width than height. Best growth in well-drained soil. AMH 3-4' AMS 4-5'

A slow growing, compact form of *Blue Spruce*. Very similar to 'R.H.Montgomery'. AMH 3-4' AMS 4-5'

SPRUCE, Dwarf Alberta:

Slow growing, very dense compact narrow pyramidal form. Very attractive soft appearance. Plant where protected from summer sun/heat. AMH 10' AMS 4'

SPRUCE, Dwarf Alberta 'Jean's Dilly':

A very dwarf form of *Dwarf Alberta Spruce*. Grows only 1-2" per year. AMH 5' AMS 3'

ARBORVITAE, 'Green Giant':

A very hardy, vigorous upright rounded shrub. Large dark green leaves with a deep yellow margin. Dense, compact plant. Best color in sunny location. Excellent accent plant. AMH 3' AMS 3' S/E/W

EUONYMUS, 'Emerald Gaiety':

Rich green leaves with white margin on dwarf, dense mounding evergreen. AMH 2' AMS 1-2' S/E/W

EUONYMUS, 'Emerald 'N Gold':

Very similar to *Emerald Gaiety* in growth habit but glossy green leaves with yellow margins. AMH 2' AMS 1-2' S/E/W

EUONYMUS, 'Golden Prince':

An extremely hardy, vigorous upright growing variegated euonymus. The new growth is golden, gradually becoming solid green, which provides a nice background for the new growth. Plant in sun for best color. AMH 3-4' AMS 3-4' S/E/W

EUONYMUS, 'Manhattan' or 'Pauli':

An upright, rounded evergreen shrub with large glossy dark green leaves. Excellent foundation plant. AMH 5' AMS 3-4' S/E/W

HOLLY, 'Berri-Magic' Royalty:

Blue Prince and *Blue Princess Holly* planted together in the container to assure bright red berries. Upright branches with dark blue-green leathery foliage. Hardy, evergreen. AMH 4-5' AMS 4-5' N/E

HOLLY, 'Blue Prince':

An extremely hardy holly with attractive blue-green foliage. Forms a natural pyramid, blooms continuously all summer providing pollination for 'Blue Princess' to produce berries. AMH 5' AMS 3' N/E

HOLLY, 'Blue Princess':

Another very hardy holly with dark lustrous blue-green foliage. Red fruit produced in abundance when pollinated by 'Blue Prince'. AMH 5' AMS 3' N/E

HOLLY, BLUE 'Castle Spire':

"NEW in 2010" A beautiful compact, pyramidal *Blue Holly* with large glossy dark green leaves, bright red berries and upright branching. AMH 6-8' AMS 3' N/E

HOLLY, 'Berri-Magic' China':

China Boy and *China Girl Holly* planted together in the same container to assure red berries. AMH 4-5' AMS 3' N/E/S/W

HOLLY, 'China Boy':

Beautiful, dense, medium green foliage covers this extremely hardy holly. Will grow in full sun or partial shade. Pollinator for 'China Girl'. AMH 4-5' AMS 3' N/E/S/W

HOLLY, 'China Girl':

A beautiful, vigorous holly with an upright, rounded growth habit. The dense branches produce an abundance of bright red berries. Will grow in full sun or partial shade. AMH 4-5' AMS 3' N/E/S/W

HOLLY, 'Foster':

Small spiny dark green leaves and loose habit of growth. Very heavy producer of small bright red berries. Sun to part shade. AMH 15' AMS 6' N/E/S/W

HOLLY, INKBERRY 'Shamrock':

An excellent, compact selection with dark, glossy green foliage and compact, rounded habit. Excellent foundation plant. AMH 3-4' AMS 3' N/E/S/W

HOLLY, 'Little Rascal':

A dwarf form of *Blue Holly* which requires very little pruning. Deep blue-green foliage becomes deep-purple in winter. Dense compact rounded form. Has very small leaves and no berries. Very hardy evergreen shrub. AMH 2' AMS 3' N/E LIMITED SUPPLY

HOLLY, 'Nellie R. Stevens':

Handsome, vigorous growing holly with glossy, blue-green foliage and large, bright red berries. Pyramidal form while young, becoming large, spreading shrub at maturity. Will grow in full sun or partial shade. AMH 6-8' AMS 5' S/E/W

HOLLY, 'Red Beauty':

A new hybrid holly with dark green, spiny leaves. Upright, broad conical form. Bright red berries late summer thru winter. AMH 10' AMS 5' S/E/W

HOLLY, 'Sky Pencil':

A densely branched evergreen accent plant with very narrow, upright form. Lustrous dark green leaves. AMH 6' AMS 1-2' S/E

MAHONIA, (Oregon Grape Holly):

Holly-like leaves, yellow flowers in spring, followed by small, blue berries. When planted in the shade, stays a bright green year around. If planted in the sun, colors change to purple bronze in the fall. BEST GROWTH IN WELL-DRAINED SOIL. AMH 5' AMS 3' S/E/W

MAHONIA, 'Compact':

Compact form of mahonia (*Oregon Grape Holly*). Smaller leaves with denser growth habit than standard mahonia. Bright green leaves turn purple-bronze in winter. MUST BE PLANTED IN WELL-DRAINED SOIL TO SURVIVE! AMH 2-3' AMS 3' S/E/W

NANDINA, 'Compacta':

A compact form with bright green, lacy foliage on upright stems. Foliage turns brilliant red during fall and winter. AMH 2-3' AMS 2-3' S/E/W

NANDINA, (Heavenly Bamboo):

Attractive, evergreen shrub with an upright habit. Lacy green foliage in summer, turning a brilliant, fiery scarlet in fall, with large clusters of red berries. White flower in spring. AMH 5' AMS 3' S/E/W

NANDINA, 'Firepower' or 'Firehouse':

A selection of dwarf nandina with larger foliage, more vigorous growth and improved winter color. Foliage becomes brilliant red from fall thru winter. Produces no flowers or fruits. For best results, mulch during winter. AMH 30" AMS 2' S/E/W

NANDINA, 'Gulf Stream':

A new selection of nandina with scarlet new growth and reddish fall/winter foliage. AMH 3' AMS 3' S/E/W

NANDINA, 'Plum Passion':

A new selection of nandina with beautiful colored foliage. New growth is deep purplish red; narrow foliage is deep green in summer and reddish-purple in winter. Best color in sunny location. AMH 3-4' AMS 3'

NANDINA, 'Sienna Sunrise':

A new selection of nandina with intense fiery red new foliage, becoming green in summer. Blooms are 6" long panicles. White flowers produce crimson berries in fall. Evergreen foliage becomes reddish during winter. Slow growth rate. AMH 3' AMS 2-3' S/E/W

NANDINA, 'Sunray':

New growth is coppery-bronze color turning deep green in summer. Brick-red fall foliage. Dense, compact plant. AMH 3' AMS 3' S/E/W

PHOTINIA, 'Fraser's':

Evergreen shrub with bright red new growth. Often called 'Red Tip'. Plant in sunny, warm location. AMH 6-8' AMS 4-5' S/W

PYRACANTHA, 'Gnome' (Yukon Belle):

Extremely hardy orange berried pyracantha with compact, densely branched spreading habit. Masses of white blooms in spring. Excellent hedge choice. AMH 4-6' AMS 6' N/E/S/W

PYRACANTHA, 'Low Boy':

Vigorous, low, spreading shrub with small evergreen foliage. White flowers in spring, bright orange berries in fall. Useful as low shrub or groundcover planting. AMH 2-3' AMS 4-6' N/E/S/W

An excellent shrub with showy white flowers in May and black berries in fall. Glossy green foliage turns brilliant red in fall. Good plant for wet areas. AMH 3-5' AMS 4'

DEUTZIA, SLENDER 'Nikko':

Very graceful, small deciduous shrub with an abundance of pure white flowers in spring. Prefers afternoon shade.

DOGWOOD, Compact Redtwig 'Isanti':

A new selection of *Redtwig Dogwood* with a dense, compact habit. White flowers in spring followed by blue berries in fall. Red stems during winter. Excellent foundation plant. Best growth in moist soil. AMH 4' AMS 3'

DOGWOOD, 'Dwarf Kelsey':

Dwarf form of *Redtwig Dogwood* shrub. Compact. Afternoon shade preferred. Best growth in moist soil. AMH 2' AMS 2'

DOGWOOD, 'Ivory Halo':

A compact selection of *Variiegated Dogwood*. Maintains dense form with minimal pruning. AMH 4-5' AMS 6'

DOGWOOD, VARIEGATED:

Bright red stems and gray-green leaves with creamy white margins. Exceptional winter color. Grows well in wet areas. Afternoon shade, moist soil required. AMH 6' AMS 6'

EUONYMUS, 'Dwarf Winged' (Burning Bush):

Excellent compact plant with corky bark and beautiful brilliant red fall color. The compact form lends it to foundation planting. Sun. AMH 5' AMS 5'

MOCKORANGE, 'Dwf. Snowflake':

A compact, upright growing shrub with brilliant yellow flowers from June until frost. Foliage turns yellow-bronze in fall. AMH 2' AMS 2'

*****VINES*****

BITTERSWEET, 'American':

Dark green, rich foliage. Rapid growing with flowers during the summer followed by clusters of orange-red berries so thick they almost cover the entire vine, lasting into winter. (Plant male and female for berries.) Sun

Hercules (Male) **Diana** (Female)

BITTERSWEET, 'Autumn Revolution':

This new variety is self-fertile, as every plant produces large quantities of bright orange-red berries each fall. Fruit is also twice as large as that of the species. Sun

CLEMATIS, 'Ernest Markham':

SILVERLACE VINE:

One of the fastest growing of all vines. Blooms with masses of white flowers in August and September. Foliage is dense, bright green. An excellent fast screen. Sun

TRUMPET VINE, 'Madame Galen':

Deep salmon red trumpet-shaped flowers appear on this vigorous growing vine. Clings without support and withstands any soil type. Sun

WISTERIA, AMERICAN 'Amethyst Falls':

*****GRASSES*****

All grasses should be cut down every spring (before new growth begins) to a height of 6" or less to allow for vigorous new growth. Best growth in sun.

BAMBOO,

'Dwarf Greenstripe':

(*Pleioblastus viridistriatus*)

Chartreuse leaves striped with dark green ribbons. Excellent spreading groundcover, great color contrast! Partial shade is best. AMH 2-3'

BAMBOO,

'Yellow Groove':

(*Phyllostachys aureosulcata*)

Tall growing bamboo with shiny dark green foliage. Semi-evergreen. Full sun. AMH 10-15'

BLUE FESCUE,

(*Festuca*) 'Elijah Blue':

Ornamental blue grass, forming a round shaped mound. Useful in rock gardens, borders, hot sunny spots. AMH 8-12"

FOUNTAIN GRASS,

(*Pennisetum Alopecuroides*):

Narrow leaf grass with cascading habit. In mid summer it is covered with fresh buff colored flower heads--about 6" long--with a pink, maroon or magenta cast. One of the best grasses for all-around garden use. AMH 2.5-3'

A medium-sized shrub, grows best in moist, acid soil. Afternoon shade is best. Heavy fruit set ripens in midsummer. Bright red fall foliage color.

BLUEBERRY, Jersey:

Large, firm berries are slightly tart and ripen in midsummer. Medium-sized shrub, grows best in moist, acid soil with afternoon shade. Beautiful burgundy-red fall color.

BLUEBERRY, Brigitta:

GRAPE, 'Himrod':

A new seedless white grape of the finest quality. Large clusters of medium-size berries, oval sweet and delicious. Requires winter protection (mulch). Ripens in late July.

RASPBERRY (Red), 'Heritage':

Bears fruit the first year, beginning in August. Upright growth, heavy bearer, excellent quality. Fruit is borne on the new growth so plants can be cut to the ground when season is over.

STRAWBERRIES, 'All Star':

June-bearing variety of excellent quality. Disease resistant with large fruit, productive.

HONEYSUCKLE (SEE VINES):

HONEYSUCKLE, 'Purple Leaf':

Evergreen. Bronze foliage in summer, purple in winter. Flowers red in bud, gold fading to yellow-white. Very fragrant. Can be sheared to make an excellent planter box or foundation shrub. Will also climb on trellis or chain link fence for colorful screen or as tall ground cover.

IVY, English, 'Thorndale':

Evergreen. One of the hardiest strains available. Deep green glossy leaves with distinctive veins. Grows best in shade.
