YEWS****

JAPANESE YEW, 'Densiformis':

A very dense, compact, spreading yew. Slower grower than other spreading yews. Like all yews, smaller size may be maintained with annual pruning.

AMH 4' AMS 6'

JAPANESE YEW, 'Emerald Spreader':

A low growing, spreading shrub with dark-green foliage. Bright red berries contrast nicely with foliage. Ideal as a shady shrub border, foundation plant, or taller ground cover. AMH 2-3' AMS 4-6'

JAPANESE YEW, 'Hicks':

An upright, columnar form with dark green foliage and red berries in fall. Very hardy.

AMH 8' AMS 5'

JAPANESE YEW, 'Nigra':

Darkest green foliage of all the yews. Rounded form. AMH 3' AMS 3'

JAPANESE YEW, 'Wardi':

A low growing, spreading yew with beautiful dark green foliage and abundant red berries. Grows twice as wide as tall.

AMH 2-3' AMS 5-6'
