

NUT TREES

Note: Best (most) pecan nut production if you plant Flowering type I and type II together.

PECAN, 'Colby':

An excellent producer in the Wichita area. Nuts are thin shelled, medium sized. Also makes an excellent shade tree.

Flowering type II AMH 30' AMS 20'

PECAN, 'Kanza':

Early maturing, cold hardy.

PECAN, 'Mohawk':

Fast growing, early ripening pecan with medium sized kernels.

Flowering type I AMH 30' AMS 20'

PECAN, 'Pawnee':

Early maturing, thin shelled.

PECAN, 'Peruque':

Cold hardy and disease resistant.

Excellent quality nuts which ripen before other varieties.

WALNUT, 'Black':

Tough native Kansas tree. Grows best in well-drained soils. AMH 30' AMS 30'

WALNUT, 'Carpathian':

English Walnut with mild flavor. Very smooth, light colored bark. Large leaves.
